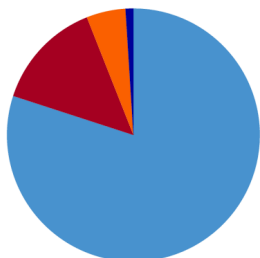


The following information is from 78% of the Class of 2014. (N= 959)

- 94% of graduates are either full-time employed or in grad school
- 80% Full-Time Employed (includes 4% in year of service or fellowships) and 14% Graduate School
- 89% of graduates had done at least one internship during college and 73% did two or more
