of grads completed at least one internship during their time at Tufts

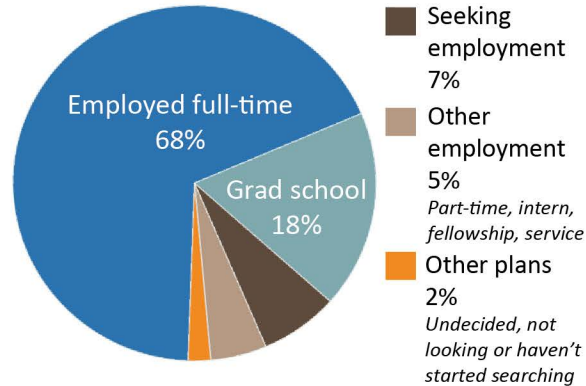

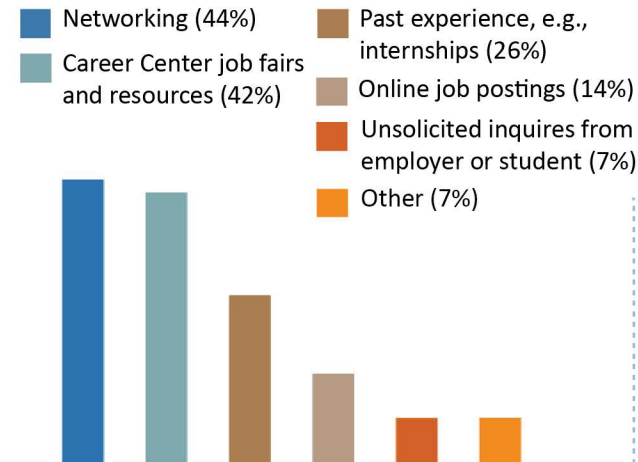

Post-Graduation Plans*

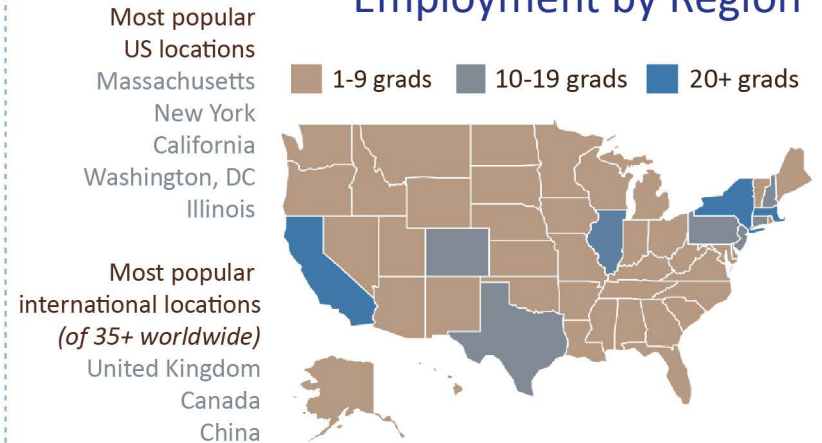

How Students Found Their Jobs

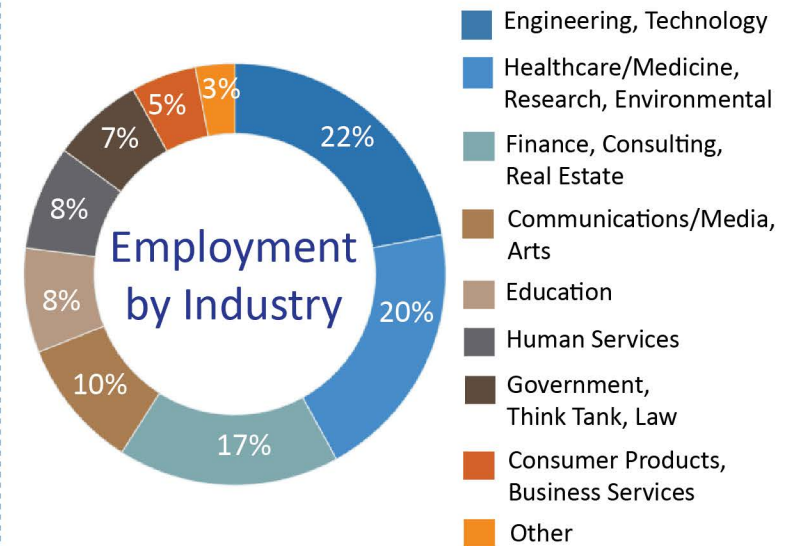


Employment by Region
