

## Undergraduate Summer Financial Aid Information

<b>Summer Financial Aid Programs</b>	
<b>Summer Scholarship</b>	<p>As a result of a gift from the Omidyar family, the Tufts Administration has made funding available to help students pay for Summer Session courses taken at Tufts. This scholarship is only for students currently enrolled at Tufts University. The amount of funding is limited and preference will be given to lower income students who need additional coursework to maintain good academic standing and meet their academic goals (Low income students are generally considered to be students with a family contribution of \$7,000 or less). International students are not eligible to receive a Summer Scholarship.</p> <p><i>Priority will be given to applications received by March 1<sup>st</sup>. Late Applications will be accepted after March 1st, but funding may be limited.</i></p> <p>Please Note: The Summer Session Scholarship will only cover the cost of tuition for up to 2 courses. Additional fees, housing, food, and other living expenses will not be funded by this Summer Scholarship. The Federal Direct Loan may be available to assist with other living expenses. You may only qualify for a Summer Scholarship once while at Tufts.</p>
<b>Federal Direct Loan</b>	<p>The Federal Direct Loan is available if a student hasn't borrowed their annual loan limit during the fall and spring semesters. You may view your aid award on SIS to see if you have reached your maximum grade level Direct Loan borrowing (\$5500 for first-years, \$6500 for sophomores and \$7500 for juniors &amp; seniors). A student must be enrolled for a minimum of 6 SHUs in order to receive Federal Direct Loan funds for the summer.</p>
<b>Federal Pell Grant</b>	<p>A Federal Pell Grant may be available if you received a Pell grant in the current academic year and are enrolled in a minimum of 6 SHUs during the summer. The amount of the summer Pell grant is based upon the amount you received during the fall and spring semester. If enrolled in 6 SHUs, the Pell grant could range from \$0 to a maximum of \$1,548. If you receive a Summer Scholarship and are eligible for a Federal Pell grant, the amount of the Summer Scholarship will be reduced by the amount of the Pell grant received.</p>
