Courses taken to fulfill requirements (foundation, distribution, concentration, minor) may NOT be taken pass/fail. A grade of D- or above will fulfill foundation and distribution requirements. In addition to these requirements, you need at least 120 SHUs with credit earned in at least 34 courses (including pre-matriculation credits) and eight semesters of full-time study. Liberal Arts students may apply up to 5 credit-bearing pre-matriculation course equivalents (adding up to at most 20 SHUs) toward their degree. Qualified courses may double-count for a maximum of two of the following requirements: culture; world civilization; or distribution. See the *Bulletin* and the university and department web pages for details on requirements.

1. Competence equivalent to six semesters in the first language.

2. Competence equivalent to three semesters of a second language (including American Sign Language).

3. Culture option: There are two ways to fulfill the culture option.

a. Continue through the fourth or fifth semester of the language used to fulfill Part I, and take one or two classes (each equaling 3 SHUs) in the same culture area as that language.

b. Complete three courses related to a single culture (each at least 3 SHUs), either the same or different from the language used to fulfill Part I. At least one of the three culture courses (adding up to at least 3 SHUs) must focus on the region of origin. Courses assigned 2 SHUs or less may be taken, but two must be taken to add up to the equivalent of one 3 SHU course. See the on-line list of all approved culture courses.

WORLD CIVILIZATION 1)

One course required (at least 3 SHUs). This course may also be used toward a culture OR a distribution, but not both.

DISTRIBUTION

Complete two courses in each area (totaling at least 6 SHUs). No more than two of the ten courses may be from the same department or program. Exception: Students may take more than two courses toward arts if courses are 2 SHUs or less. Students who matriculated before fall 2018 may only use one credit-bearing pre-matriculation course equivalent toward each of the five distribution areas (at least 3 SHUs must be completed after matriculation). No single course may be used in more than one distribution area. Only one ExCollege course (no matter how many SHUs) can be used toward distribution requirements.
